Our general manager will report to the board of directors, which is elected by the cooperative. The general manager has the authority to hire and direct all staff.

The General Manager is responsible for overseeing the daily operations of the store, ensuring financial sustainability, fostering a cooperative culture and providing excellent customer service. This role requires leadership, strategic planning and community engagement to align with the values and mission of the cooperative.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee daily operations including inventory management, cash management, daily reporting, ordering, stocking, merchandising, ensuring smooth operations and high customer satisfaction.
- Manage all purchasing and stock control, including vendor negotiations, inventory forecasting, and loss prevention, adhering to board-directed policies to ensure optimal product availability and minimize waste.
- Ensure compliance with food safety, health regulations, labor laws and cooperative policies.
- Maintain a clean, safe and welcoming store environment ensuring it's organized and well stocked.
- Ability to work flexible hours.
- Monitor and improve store efficiency, including POS systems and technology.

- Prepare and analyze monthly Profit & Loss statements, balance sheets, and sales reports to monitor financial performance, identify trends, and implement necessary adjustments to achieve profitability goals. Monitor daily sales to adjust to board-approved budgets.
- Hire, train and supervise staff, fostering a positive and collaborative workplace culture.
- Schedule and delegate tasks to promote efficient operations.
